Allentown Recycling Center: 1400 Martin Luther King Jr. Dr, Allentown (610.437.8729) will recycle clean glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, tin and bimetal cans, cardboard, office paper and magazines, newspapers, paperboard, telephone books, good used clothing, hardback and paperback books, #1 and #2 plastics, scrap metals. Bethlehem Recycling Center: Illick's Mill Road between Schoenersville Rd and Center St, Bethlehem (610.865.7082) will recycle aerosol cans, plastics #1 through #7 and styrofoam, clothing and textiles. Open M-F 10AM-4PM, Saturday 9AM-4PM, and Sunday 11AM-3 PM. www.bethlehem-pa.gov/recycle
