Call to Order: The regular meeting of the Lynn Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Justin N. Smith, at 6:30 pm in the Municipal Building. Present were Chairman Justin N. Smith, Vice Chairman Steve I. Feinour, Member Brian C. Dietrich, Secretary/Treasurer Tammy M. White, Admin/Zoning office Secretary Kathy A. Hermany, Road Master Bruce Raber, Engineer Chris Noll, Solicitor Marc Fisher, and approximately 10 citizens.

Pledge of Allegiance: The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

Media Representation: Kenny Bleiler, NWP.

Public Comment: None

Accept the Minutes and Direct the Treasurer to pay the bills: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Steve I. Feinour to accept the minutes from 07/13/17 and direct the treasurer to pay the bills. Motion carried unanimously.

Fire Companies: Deputy Fire Chief, Gary Kuntz reported the monthly report for New Tripoli Fire Company. Three additional background checks where turned into the township office for new firefighters; September 23rd is guns and cash bas from 4-8pm; A FEMA Grant Award for \$22,858.00 has been accepted for the purchase of a gear extractor and gear dryer; A demo is scheduled for August 15th; Regional fire picnic is scheduled for September 30th @ Ontelaunee Park.; Weisenberg Township has had their Solicitor review the ordinance for tax rebate and has come back with no changes. Tammy M. White will forward the email containing the draft to Marc Fisher. Fire Chief, Clark Mantz from Lynnport Fire Company also gave his monthly report.

Road Report: Bruce Raber, Road master, reported for the month of August: (1) Memory Rd. ready for millings. Cleaned out gutters & regraded. (2) Double chipped Memory rd. (3) Swept all roads that were oiled & chipped. (4) Worked on dirt roads. (5) Cut grass and weed wacked at recycling center. (6) Over ½ way around the township with 2nd round of shoulder mowing. (7) Helped 3 other townships with paving projects – oil & chip – putting down millings. (8) Made repairs to trucks & equipment. (9) Got Hummingbird Rd. ready to pave and completed paving. (10) Hauled 2 loads of scrap metal from recycling center = \$185.00. Anticipated work for <u>August:</u> (1) Continue should mowing. (2) Shoulder paving on Oswald Rd. (small project). (3) Cold patching.

Park: MS4 Waiver: Chris Noll stated he has gotten no response but we should be in good shape. Pedestrian Bridge: Chris Noll and Bruce Raber met at the dog park to gather information regarding the trestle/bridge. LB Fencing (Roy Martin) will be contacted to inspect the area for fencing. Bruce Raber also added that they will work on building the berm as soon as it dries out. Old Pavilion: Kathy Hermany will gather 5 quotes on the raising of the old pavilion before the September board meeting.

Mini Cell tower Ordinance: Marc Fisher called the public hearing to order at 6:40 pm and reviewed the proposed Ordinance 2017-02. No comments were received and the public hearing closed at 6:42pm. A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Steve I. Feinour to adopt Ordinance 2017-02; AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF LYNN TOWNSHIP, LEHIGH COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ESTABLISHING STANDARDS FOR THE SITING, DESIGN, PERMITTING, USE AND MAINTENANCE OF COMMERCIAL COMMUNICATION FACILITIES. Motion carried unanimously. The motion was created to be proactive.

Miscellaneous: (1) Burned out trailer update: The demo is under way. BOS agreed to have it seeded. (2) Leaser Lake Bathroom permit fees: A motion was made by Steve I. Feinour and seconded by Brian C. Dietrich to waive the septic permit fees with Scott Bieber. Motion carried unanimously. (3) Sassafras Road: A civil enforcement will be sent to the owner regarding the ongoing issue at 7934 Sassafras Road. (4) Office Roof: The BOS directed Kathy Hermany to obtain 3 quotes for the office building roof. The roof recently had temporary repairs done. (5) Maintenance Garage Roof: The BOS directed Bruce Raber to move forward with the repairs/replacement of the maintenance (front) garage roof. The project will be done in house and the cost will run approximately \$6,200.00.
