Board of Supervisors Thursday, August 14th, 2014 @ 6:30 PM Lynn Twp.~7911 Kings Hgwy., New Tripoli

<u>Call to Order</u>: The regular meeting of the Lynn Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Justin N. Smith, at 6:30 pm in the Municipal Building. Present were Chairman Justin N. Smith, Vice Chairman Steve I Feinour, Member Brian C. Dietrich, Secretary/Treasurer Tammy M. White, Road Master Bruce Raber, Engineer Chris Noll, Solicitor Marc Fisher, and approximately 13 citizens.

Pledge of Allegiance: The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

NWP Reporter: Kenny Bleiler

<u>Public Comment:</u> (1) <u>Resident, Kermit DeLong</u> resurfaced his driveway and gutter and asked the BOS if it was refundable to him from the Township. The BOS agreed no, not without prior approval.

Accept the Minutes and Direct the Treasurer to pay the bills: A motion was made by Steve I. Feinour and seconded by Brian C. Dietrich to accept the minutes from 07/10/14 and direct the treasurer to pay the bills. Motion carried unanimously.

Subdivisions: Greg Snyder Resolution #2014-14: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Steve I Feinour adopting Resolution 2014-14; A RESOLUTION FOR PLAN REVISION FOR NEW LAND DEVELOPMENT. Motion carried unanimously. Steve I. Feinour stated a follow up should be done with Frank Leist and then after that have the Township secretary write a letter, but first talk to Frank Leist at LCA. Nancy Smith sewage planning module: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Steve I. Feinour approving the sewage planning module for transmittal and approval to DEP. Motion carried unanimously. A second motion as made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Justin N. Smith approving a one year extension for Nancy Smith. Steve I. Feinour stated he felt one year was too long. Motion carried. Susan Schall Extension: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Steve I. Feinour granting an extension for Susan Schall. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Fire Companies:</u> Fire Chief, Peter Christ reported the monthly report for New Tripoli Fire Company and thanked the road crew for helping them with millings from Penn Dot.

Road Report: Bruce Raber, Road master, reported for the month of July: (1) Cut shoulders on some of our black top roads. (2) Hauled scrap metal from recycling center - \$151.20. (3) Installed new road pipe. (4) Did some weed whacking at intersections and around guide rail. (5) Trimmed tree branches from in front of stop signs for better visibility. (6) Finished up oil & chipping for the year. (7) Swept all roads that were oiled & chipped. (8) Made repairs at inlet ends of pipes. (9) Cold patched pot holes on some black top roads. (10) Helped Heidelberg & Lowhill Twp's with their oil & chipping. (11) ½ way around the township with the 2nd round of shoulder mowing. Anticipated work for August: (1) Double yellow lines painted on toads. (2) Install a new road pipe. (3) Set up for Night in the Country. (4) Fill pot holes on dirt roads. (5) Cut more shoulders of roads. PT Road Crew: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Steve I. Feinour to approve the hiring of Shawn Nealon as a PT road crew to be used as needed and wages to be \$13.50/hour. Motion carried unanimously. Mandated signs: Bruce Raber also informed the BOS that it is mandated by the state that signs will need to be updated in order to pass state requirements. Bruce Raber added that all of the stop signs have been done along with some chevron signs and that the road name signs are ok and additional signs will be updated as needed. Truck: Under miscellaneous, Bruce Raber informed the BOS that he should start looking into a new/truck.

Ordinance 2014-05: Solicitor, Marc Fisher opened the hearing at 6:52 pm for Ordinance 2014-05 discussion was held and the hearing was closed at 6:56 pm. A motion was made by Steve I. Feinour and seconded by Justin N. Smith approving Ordinance 2014-05; AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF LYNN TOWNSHIP, LEHIGH COUNTY, PA AMENDING THE LYNN TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE BY AMENDING THE LYNN TOWNSHIP ZONING MAP TO REZONE CERTAIN PROPERTIES IN AND BETWEEN PA ROUTE 309 AND WEISS ROAD FROM, AGRICULTURE PRESERVATION ("AP") TO GENERAL COMMERCIAL/GENERAL INDUSTRIAL ("GC/GI"). Motion was carried. Brian C. Dietrich voted no and stated he was in agreement with LVPC letter dated May 30, 2014 and Heidelberg Township letter dated July 10, 2014. Steve I. Feinour stated he was surprised with Heidelberg Townships comments because they have commercial business located in their Township but don't think Lynn Township should zone commercial.

<u>Concert in the Park:</u> The Large Flower Heads Contract: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Steve I. Feinour approving the contract for The Large Flower Heads. Motion carried unanimously.

Miscellaneous: (1) Ponderosa Ct.: The BOS informed Residents of Ponderosa Ct. that a site meeting was held on 7/17/14 and discussed maintenance of the swales and installing pipes and inlets. Swale maintenance was elected to pursue. Either option will not solve the ground water table issue and the wet basements. Legal questions were forwarded to the Township Solicitor, Marc Fisher regarding what the responsibility of the Township in regards to; a. installing pipes and inlets; b. possibility of it being a private issue between the property owners; c. Township obligation to fix Mr. McClellands driveway; d. issuance of permit for 9639 Ponderosa Ct. (2) Park Survey: The BOS stated that Mr. Brown would be contacted to start with the priorities in the Park survey as well as a meeting with the REC Commission and

Historical Society. (3) <u>Food Pantry</u>: Steve I. Feinour stated the individuals at the Food Pantry understand why the Township did not give a donation but noted that they did not solicit the Township for funds. (4) Thank You: Justin N. Smith thanked the Township staff for doing a good job. (5) (6)

<u>Public Comment</u>: (1) Resident, Kermit E. DeLong stated that the New Tripoli Bank Signs, located in the peeks of the new pavilion in the Park, are very difficult to see. Discussion was held to possibily hang the signs on the side of the pavilion or get a price on a bigger sign.

Announcements: (1) Night in the Country is scheduled for Saturday, August 16, 2014 with a rain date of Sunday, August 17, 2014. (2) Sunday, September 14, 2014 from 4pm till 7pm the Todd Wolfe Band in Ontelaunee Park.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Steve I. Feinour and seconded by Brian C. Dietrich to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 7:44 pm.
