## Board of Supervisors Thursday, February 12th, 2015 @ 6:30 PM Lynn Twp.~7911 Kings Hgwy., New Tripoli

<u>Call to Order</u>: The regular scheduled meeting of the Lynn Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Justin N. Smith at 6:30 pm in the Municipal Building. Present were Chairman Justin N. Smith, Vice Chairman Steve I. Feinour, Member Brian C. Dietrich, Solicitor Marc Fisher, Engineer/Zoning Officer Roy Stewart and Chris Noll, Secretary/Treasurer Tammy M. White, Admin/Zoning office Secretary Kathy A. Hermany, Road Master Bruce Raber, and approximately 40 citizens.

Pledge of Allegiance: The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

Media Representation: Kenny Blieler, NWP; TV13; WFMZ.

Public Comment: 1. Resident, Kathy Van Allen asked the BOS if the public was going to hear the proposal. Justin N. Smith noted that nothing has changed and that a resolution will be adopted later in the meeting. 2. Resident John Halasovski stated he was not pleased with how it was plowed at his driveway on Sassafras Rd. The BOS stated they would look into it.

Accept the Minutes and Direct the Treasurer to pay the bills: A motion was made by Steve I. Feinour and seconded by Brian C. Dietrich approving the BOS minutes from 01/05/15 re-org meeting and directing the treasurer to pay the bills. Motion carried unanimously. A second motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Steve I. Feinour approving the joint ambulance meeting from 01/13/15. Motion carried unanimously.

Ambulance Update: Resolution 2015-15: A motion was made by Steve I. Feinour and seconded by Brian C. Dietrich approving Resolution 2015-15; A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF LYNN TOWNSHIP, LEHIGH COUNTY, PA APPOINTING EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE PROVIDERS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP. Motion carried unanimously. Cetronia Ambulance Corps was designated as the primary emergency medical service provider within Lynn Township. Northern Valley Emergency Medical Services was designated as the second-due emergency medical service provider within Lynn Township.

Subdivision: Waiver Kerry & Sandy Hamm: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Steve I. Feinour granting the Waiver request upon condition of indemnification agreement and that it is recorded in Lehigh County. Motion carried unanimously. Snyder Farms Sewage Planning Module: Resolution 2015-13 A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Steve I. Feinour approving Resolution 2015-13; A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF LYNN TOWNSHIP, LEHIGH COUNTY PA FOR PLAN REVISION FOR NEW LAND DEVELOPMENT, WHICH IS INCLUDED IN THE SEWAGE PLANNING MODULE. Motion carried unanimously.

Fire Companies: NTFC Fire Chief, Peter Christ presented the BOS with a report for January 2015 as well as a recap of 2014. Mr. Christ also supplied the township with a book of the standard operating guidelines of the NTFC. Peter Christ also added that the NTFC has bids out for architects. Bids will be received back March 9<sup>th</sup> and will be opened at the station. LPFC Fire Chief, Clark Mantz presented the BOS with their report from January 2015. Jason Nestor, treasurer of LPFC asked the BOS if they need LPFC financials. Justin N. Smith stated that as a board they do not want to medal in FC business. GVFC Asst. Fire Chief, Randy Metzger asked the BOS to sign a Memorandum of Understanding between GVFC, LPFC, Heidelberg Twp., Lowhill Twp., and Lynn Twp. Once the BOS reviews the Memorandum, Chairman Justin N. Smith will sign and return to GVFC. The memo is needed for getting grant funds. Justin N. Smith also stated that he would like to have the fire companies get together for a meeting to compile a Fire Study to help aid in the future of Lynn Twp. LPFC 1<sup>st</sup> Assistant Chief, Troy Christman added that there was a North West Regional Service Committee formed years back, back the committee has not been meeting.

Road Report: Bruce Raber, Road master, reported for the month of <u>January</u>: (1) Changed oil and serviced Boom Mower. (2) Boom Mowing. (3) Did a lot of treating and plowing roads and put stone on dirt roads. (4) Made repairs to plows, salt spreaders and trucks. (5) Repaired and replaced some road signs. Anticipated work for <u>February</u>: (1) Continue boom mowing. (2) Tree Trimming. New Truck: Bruce Raber reviewed a possible purchase of a 2004 55 Ford with 60K mileage. The BOS were in agreement for Bruce Raber to research and gather information for the purchase of a new truck.

PENNDOT Agreement: RT. 863/Behler Road: Engineer, Roy Stewart stated that he will put together a letter to be put on township letter head, to be sent to Dept. of Transportation.

Brown & Brown: Master Plan: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Steve I. Feinour approved the Comprehensive Park Plan and authorized KCE paperwork for the NPDES permits and other required documents/permits. Motion carried unanimously. Steve I. Feinour thanked Nestle for the monetary donations. The BOS also stated that the results from the Park survey indicated that the top 3 things residents requested where historical items, dog park, more playground equipment/Frisbee golf. Kathy Hermany stated that there is a class being offered at the Hershey convention this spring regarding dog parks. Kathy Hermany also has researched playground equipment for ages 5-12 years of age and the cost would run between 20K and 40K. Kathy Hermany also has been in contact with Upper Macungie regarding their Frisbee golf.

Ag Security: Prange 17.4 acres A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Steve I. Feinour to acknowledge receipt of the Ag proposal and to authorize the staff and solicitor to move forward with the necessary paper work. Motion carried unanimously.

The Allentown Band Agreement: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Steve I. Feinour approving the contract for The Allentown Band. Motion carried unanimously. The Allentown Band will hold their concert in Ontelaunee park on Sunday, June 14, 2015 @ 2:30pm.

Resolution 2015-14: A motion was made by Steve I. Feinour and seconded by Brian C. Dietrich adopting Resolution 2015-14; A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF LYNN TOWNSHIP, LEHIGH COUNTY, PA FOR THE TRANSFER OF MONEY FROM SUBDIVISION/ESCROW FUND TO THE GFMM. Motion carried unanimously. The transfer of money was to close subdivisions #10-02 Christopher Zajacik/Ontelaunee Apartments and #14-02 Wertman Farms.

**EAC Vacancy:** No appointees.

VISA Application: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Steve I. Feinour authorizing the submission of the VISA application. Motion carried unanimously.

Miscellaneous: (1) Asst. Emergency Management Coordinator: Tabled. (2) Chris Noll: Chris Noll will work with Kathy Hermany to get the names of Carl Wolf's open accounts with Lynn Twp. (3) LCA: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Steve I. Feinour authorizing Tammy M. White to forward the annual report of municipal authorities for the Sewer Authority to Lehigh County and marked as inactive. Motion carried unanimously. (4) 2014 Audit: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Steve I. Feinour authorizing payment of \$75/hour to Monica Rabert as a consultant to the elected Auditors. Motion carried unanimously. (5) Ambulance: Justin N. Smith announced that Lynn Township will be temporarily housing the Cetronia ambulance at the township location. Numerous other options were discussed and will be looked at by the BOS and hopefully have something by the end of spring or the beginning of summer. NOVA representative, Joseph Solderich thanked the BOS.

<u>Public Comment</u>: (1) Further discussion was held by the BOS and numerous residents of Lynn Township regarding the decision to go with Cetronia Ambulance Corp.
