Call to Order: The regular meeting of the Lynn Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Justin N. Smith, at 6:30 pm in the Municipal Building. Present were Chairman Justin N. Smith, Absent~Vice Chairman Steve I. Feinour, Member Brian C. Dietrich, Secretary/Treasurer Tammy M. White, Asst. Secretary/Treasurer Kathy Hermany Road Master Bruce Raber, Engineer Chris Noll, Solicitor Marc Fisher, and approximately 40 citizens.

<u>Pledge of Allegiance</u>: The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

Media Representation: Kenny Blieler

Public Comment: Transfer Station- Numerous residents attending the meeting to voice their concerns about the Possibility of the Transfer Station closing. The residents were in favor of keeping the Transfer Station opened. A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Justin N. Smith to up the cost @ the transfer station from \$5, \$8, \$10 per size bags, to \$7, \$10, \$12 per size bags, and to up the recycling from \$2 to \$5 ~ and to re-evaluate in December 2019. Motion carried.

Accept the Minutes and Direct the Treasurer to pay the bills: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Justin N. Smith to accept the minutes from 05/09/19 and to direct the treasurer to pay the bills. Motion carried.

Fire Companies: LPFC President, Darryl Schafer reported for the month of May: 9/17/19 will be LPFC 75th Anniversary. expansion plans are moving along. NTFC Fire Chief, Peter Christ reported for the month of May: May 2019 fire call report was submitted, 1st Female Graduate (Nicole Mark) graduated from the Bucks FF1 Academy on June 5th, ropes & Rigging Class 6/3, 17 & 22, 1 FF completed his pro board haz-mat awareness & operations, 2 FF will be attending pump 2 class at West Penn, 1 FF pump 1 class at Emerald, Truck 1 & 2 being held at Germansville FD July & beginning of August, Open house at new station June 23rd from 11:00 am. to 2:00 pm., a clothing shed is located in the NTFC parking lot. Drywell: Justin N. Smith will look into a key for the drywell located @ the townhouses. A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Justin N. Smith approving the assistance of the Fire Police on August 17th for "A Night in the Country". Motion carried.

Subdivision: Paul Kuhn Extension: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Justin N. Smith approving the extension through August 31, 2019. Motion carried. Overlay District Village Center: Discussion was held regarding the Overlay District in Village Center. Chris Noll will make the necessary changes to include, more than 1 use in Village Center but will still require a special exception, and present it at the July 11th BOS meeting. Tammy M. White was directed to write a letter to LCA requesting their attendance a the July 11th BOS meeting.

Road Report: Bruce Raber, Road master, reported for the month of May: (1) Finished up paving projects (Owl Valley Rd. ~ Miller Rd. ~ Autumn Rd. ~ Reeser Rd. ~ Gun Club Rd. ~ Quarry Rd.) (2) Put up the New Volley ball Net which now finishes the volley ball courts. (3) Repaired and replaced stop signs ~ speed limit signs and put up 4 new slow children at play & 15 mph signs. (4) Paved the parking lot in the park. (5) Cut shoulders ~ cleaned out gutters and opened pipes. (6) Hauled scrap metal + \$41.30-\$54.60 & Aluminum cans = \$204.00. (7) Made repairs to our black top roller. (8) About 1/2 the shoulder mowing has been completed. (9) Started oiling & Chip in Weisenberg Twp. Anticipated work for June: (1) Get roads ready to oil & chip. (2) Oil & chip roads.

Proposed Ag Security: Adam Geiger Proposal: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Justin N. Smith approving receipt of the proposal and to direct the staff and solicitor to process the necessary paperwork. Motion carried.

Proposed Sewer Amendments Update:

Certificate of deposit maturity notice: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Justin N. Smith to take the matured CD ending in 231 and roll it over into a 60 month CD along with the accumulated interest. Motion carried.

Executive Session: An executive session was called at 7:44 pm to discuss personnel issues. Brian C. Dietrich, Justin N. Smith, and Bruce Raber were in attendance of the session. The regular meeting was called back in session at 7:52 pm. A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Justin N. Smith to hire Donovan White as a Full Time employee at the rate of \$15/hr, and he will work on the Road Crew and in Ontelaunee Park. Motion carried. A second motion was made by Justin N. Smith and seconded by Brian C. Dietrich to pay Tina Snyder \$15/hr. as a Part Time park employee. Motion carried.

Multi Municipal Comprehensive Plan Service Agreement: The BOS would like to review it further and will discuss at the July 11th BOS meeting.

Park: DCED Grant: Chris Noll stated that the DCED Grant for the splash pad has been submitted. Dog Park: a light for the dog park area is in the works. Chris Noll will check into it.

Miscellaneous: (1) Night in the Country: A motion was made by Justin N. Smith and seconded by Brian C. Dietrich authorizing the fire police to control parking and traffic control during the event. Motion carried. (2) Edgeone: A motion was made by Justin N. Smith and seconded by Brian C. Dietrich approving Edgeone Property Services to line paint the

newly paved area in the park and to also approve Edgeone to provide mowing to the playground area on Lincoln court @ \$50 per cut. Motion carried.

Public Comment: ATV's are not allowed in the park. There are currently signs.
