Call to Order: The regular meeting of the Lynn Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Justin N. Smith, at 6:30 pm in the Municipal Building. Present were Chairman Justin N. Smith, Vice Chairman Steve I. Feinour, Member Brian C. Dietrich, Secretary/Treasurer Tammy M. White, Road Master Bruce Raber, Engineer Rep./Zoning Officer Chris Noll, Solicitor Marc Fisher, and approximately 8 citizens.

<u>Pledge of Allegiance</u>: The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

Accept the Minutes and Direct the Treasurer to pay the bills: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Steve I. Feinour to accept the minutes from 10/10/19 BOS meeting and to direct the treasurer to pay the bills. Motion carried unanimously.

Fire Companies: LPFC Asst. Fire Chief, Tim VanBlargan: 58 calls for the year; 4 members completed ropes 1 class; 4 members attended hazmat awareness pro board class and now need to take the written test Thursday 11/21; Gun bingo is Saturday 11/16 doors open at 5pm games stat at 7pm, event is sold out; Turkey raffle is 11/22 doors open a 6pm; Renovations for the Social Hall will begin in December. NTFC Asst. Fire Chief, Gary Kuntz: 141 calls as of 11/14/19; 3 firefighters completed ropes I held at the Kempton Fire Co.; 2 firefighters completed vehicle rescue awareness and operations held at Coplay Fire Co.; 2 firefighters completed special vehicle rescue certification held at Catasauqua Fire Co.; Rescue 1741 provided equipment and manpower for the special vehicle rescue class held at Yocum Towing; 1 firefighter completed Haz-mat awareness certification; New Tripoli attended a joint training with Germansville Fire Co. and the Lehigh County Drone team on 10/20 at Bake Oven Knob. The Lehigh County Drone team is a resource that can be used at multiple incident types; NTFC will be hosting a meeting with the PA Stat Game Commission and the National Park Service on Monday, November 18th after a recent incident along the Appalachian trail. Dietrich approving Resolution 2019-17; A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LYNN, LEHIGH COUNTY, FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 2020. Motion carried unanimously. The Resolution was approved keeping the millage of Lynn Township 0.2 mills.
