<u>Call to Order</u>: The regular meeting of the Lynn Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Vice Chairman Brian C. Dietrich, at 6:30 pm in the Municipal Building. Present were Vice Chairman Brian C. Dietrich, Member Steve I. Feinour, Secretary/Treasurer Tammy M. White, Asst. Secretary/Treasurer Kathy Hermany Road Master Bruce Raber, Engineer Chris Noll, Solicitor Marc Fisher, and approximately 6 citizens. Absent, Chairman Justin N. Smith.

Pledge of Allegiance: The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

Media Representation: Sariet Laschinsky, NW Press.

Public Comment: None.

Accept the Minutes and Direct the Treasurer to pay the bills: A motion was made by Steve I. Feinour and seconded by Brian C. Dietrich to accept the minutes from 05/14/20 and to direct the treasurer to pay the bills. Motion carried.

Fire Companies: NTFC Fire Chief, Peter Christ reported (via email) for the month of May: 67 fire responses as of 6/8/2020; cost to replace 1741 Rollover Protection Control Module is \$4,208.47; Weekly trainings have started again; Waiting to hear when classes that were postponed or cancelled will be rescheduled by Bucks County Community College; Father's Day chicken BBQ, June 21st starting at 11:00 am till sold out. Drive thru pick up only.

<u>Subdivision-</u> Waiver for Lot Consolidation: A motion was made by Steve I. Feinour approving the waiver request dated June 5, 2020 for a Lot Consolidation Waiver request located on the southwest corner of Flint Hill Road and Long Court. Motion carried. A second motion was made by Steve I. Feinour and seconded by Brian C. Dietrich granting approval contingent on a note being added that it supersedes the previous approved plan and that the waiver included note and that it is reviewed by the Lehigh Valley Planning Commission. Motion carried. Elaine Peter is consolidation Lot No.2 back to the original farm tract (Lot No. 1). There is no construction/development proposed for the lot consolidation.

Road Report: Bruce Raber, Road master, reported for the month of <u>May</u>: (1) Helped Weisenberg Twp. with paving projects. (2) Did Lynn's paving projects with the help from the 3 other twp.; Gun Club rd. from 143 to Lentz Rd and Lentz Road. (3) Filled Pot Holes on Dirt roads. (4) Did some cold patching on Roads to be oiled & chipped. (5) Started shoulder mowing. (6) Hauled scrap metal from Recycling Center \$103.60. Anticipated work for <u>June</u>: (1) Get roads ready to oil & chip. (2) Oil & chip roads. <u>Ross Valley Bridge</u>: Bruce spoke with the crew that is working on the bridge and the demolition part of the bridge is scheduled to start Monday, June 15, 2020. So far the work that has been done looks great.

<u>Park:</u> <u>Pond:</u> Bruce Raber met with Ed Eoster from Coon Hollow Inc. regarding the pipes that need to be replaced for the pond inlet. A new pipe will be installed with a shut off valve and another small pipe will run off of it. Bruce Raber also met with Ronnie Utt who will doing the project. Ronnie Utt said he was ordering the supplies needed to complete the job.

<u>Certificate of deposit maturity notice:</u> A motion was made by Steve I. Feinour and seconded by Brian C. Dietrich to take the matured CD ending in 257 and roll it over into a 60 month CD along with the accumulated interest. Motion carried.

Miscellaneous: (1) Blue Mnt. Winery: Chris Noll spoke with the owner regarding a noise issue. Chris Noll stated that the owner is aware and now knows the guidelines to follow for outdoor music and there should not be another issue. (2) Cemetery Deed: Marc Fisher stated that the acquisition with the cemetery is complete and filed at the Courthouse. (3) NW Graduation: Leroy Bogart was not present at the meeting but wanted the BOS to know how thankful they were that the NWL Seniors were able to drive through the Park to acknowledge their graduation banners that adorned the driveway through the park. (4) Donats Peek Road: Chris Noll will contact the state regarding how long the shutdown of Donats Peak Road will be. (5) Resignation: A motion was made by Steve I. Feinour and seconded by Brian C. Dietrich accepting the Resignation Letter (Via Email) from David C. Najarian sent May 26, 2020, resigning as Elected Auditor.

<u>Public Comment</u>: Eagle Scout Project: Reed Conrey, a senior at NWL, presented the BOS with his proposed Eagle Scout Project to construct a walkway from the existing sidewalk in Ontelaunee Park to the soon to be new location of the WWII Memorial that will be moved to the park from the corner lot at Ebenezer Church. The BOS were in favor of Reed moving forward with his project with direction from the Township Engineer, Chris Noll. Reed Conrey stated that he is hoping to have the project completed by the end of October 2020.
