<u>Call to Order:</u> The regular meeting of the Lynn Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Justin N. Smith, at 6:30 pm in the Municipal Building. Present were Chairman Justin N. Smith, Vice Chairman Brian C. Dietrich, Absent was member Steve I. Feinour, Secretary/Treasurer Tammy M. White, Admin/Zoning office Secretary Kathy A. Hermany, Road Master Bruce Raber, Engineer Chris Noll, Solicitor Marc Fisher, and approximately 23 citizens.

<u>Pledge of Allegiance</u>: The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

Media Representation: Sarit Laschinsky from the NW Press.

Public Comment: 1. Residents, Troy and Tina Everett were present to address the board with the ongoing issue of the property located at the end of Hoffadeckel Ct. that is defacing the other properties located on Hoffadeckel Ct. The BOS stated that they will take care of the issue.

Accept the Minutes and Direct the Treasurer to pay the bills: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Justin N. Smith to accept the minutes from 07/09/20 and direct the treasurer to pay the bills. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Subdivision:</u> Penn's View Planning Module: Chris Noll stated the modules where in complete to be signed.

Ordinance Review: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Justin N. Smith authorizing Solicitor, Marc Fisher to clean up the ordinance and advertise. Motion carried unanimously.

Fire Companies: LPFC 2nd Asst. Fire Chief, Tim VanBlargan reported for the LPFC: 44 emergency calls for the year; Roof project is fully completed; 2 members have completed Mod 2 Class and have started Mod 3 classes; Drive thru hoagie sale on August 29th, large Italian hoagie only with or without onions. Orders are due by Friday the 21st pickup is 12 noon - 2pm; Golf tournament September 26th @ Rich Maiden Golf Course. Shot Gun start at 8am please contact Scott Greenawalt to sign up. Final Registration is September 12th; Keep checking Lynnport's FB page for upcoming raffles with some big prizes on weekends such as a Polaris ATV, 4 wheel drive John Deere Lawn Tractor, Jacuzzi hot tub and for Labor Day they will be raffling off a good American made Harley from Schaeffer's Harley-Davidson in Orwigsburg. NTFC Fire Chief, Peter Christ reported for the NTFC: 94 fire responses as of 8/11/2020; 1 FF enrolled in Whitehall Fire Academy; started on line raffles to supplement lost income for not holding in person guns-n-cash bash; guns-n-cash raffle only to be held September 14th @ 7:45pm live on FB; yard sale & food trucks Sept. 12th form 8am to 2pm; chicken BBQ Sept. 13th from 11am to 2pm drive thru. Presale tickets available.

Road Report: Bruce Raber, Road master, reported for the month of July: (1) 4 dumpsters at Recycling Center have been repaired for recycling; hauled 2 loads of scrap metal @ \$75.20 and \$105.00; aluminum cans @ \$80.00.(2) Dug out 6 tree stumps at train station in park. (3) Filled pot holes on dirt roads. (4) Finished up sweeping roads that were oiled & chipped. (5) Helped Heidelberg Twp. with their oil & chip. (6) Ross Valley Bridge project has been completed & final approval by Ryan Christman and Bruce Raber. (7) Cut grass & weed wacked at Recycling Center. (8) Spread screenings on Reeser Rd. where old oil pushed through. (9) Re-graded hills on dirt roads that washed out from heavy rain. (10) Cut up trees that came down from tropical storm. (11) Made repairs to large pipe on Hummingbird Rd. that got washed out due to tropical storm and also made repairs to a large pipe on Springhouse Road that we lost due to tropical storm/heavy rain. Anticipated work for August: (1) Re-grade mainly hills of dirt roads that washed out due to tropical storm/heavy rain. (2) If & when all repairs from tropical storm damage are finished we may do some paving. (3) Double yellow lines are to be painted on roads. Ross Valley Bridge: The Bridge is complete and a motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Justin N. Smith approving the additional \$5,850.00 for items not originally addressed in the original contract. Motion carried unanimously. New Hires: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Justin N. Smith to Hire Jacob Werley as FT road crew employee @ the rate of \$17.50/hour and to hire Brandon Wehr as a FT employee @ the rate of \$15.00/hour split between the Park and Road Crew. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Park:</u> <u>Trees</u> - There are 55 dead trees in Ontelaunee Park. The BOS directed Bruce Raber to contact tree removal companies to give a quote and possibly have it split up between 4 years.

Resolution 2020-10: A motion was made by Brian C. Dietrich and seconded by Justin N. Smith approving Resolution 2020-10 for the transfer of unencumbered moneys from one township account to another. Motion carried unanimously. The resolution was to close the Paul Kuhn subdivision.

<u>Miscellaneous:</u> (1) <u>LCA Corrected Letter</u>- Chris Noll stated that there was a comprehensive meeting held and will continue to bring everyone up to date.

Public Comment: (1) Cable/WIFI/Internet: Numerous residents were present at the board meeting to address the BOS with their concerns for Cable/WIFI/Internet to rural areas in Lynn Township that do not have coverage. Amie Graham of 7618 Gypsy Moth Drive, Spoke on behalf of everyone. Amie did state there are grants available from Covid relief \$\$ that the Township may be eligible for. The BOS informed Amie that grants can take up to 2 years. Amie has been in contact with KIT Communications that are willing to access a bridge to the existing infra structure with BRC, with costs being a lot less than having the individuals paying to have the service run in by BRC. The board along with Marc Fisher suggested to Amie Graham to proceed as follows: 1. Compile a list of all the geographic areas & property addresses in Lynn Township

that currently do not have coverage. **2.** Contact BRC to even see if they would entertain hybrid systems. Tammy White will write BRC a letter. **3.** Check into House Bill 2438 and Senate Bill 835. **4.** Check with Lehigh County to see what amount of \$\$ they are sending and how it can be used. **Note:** The township did not apply for the cares act \$\$, however someone did, and the township is expected to receive \$\$. Tammy will call Frank Kane, LHV director of community & economic development at Lehigh County. **5.** Contact Senator Pat Browne. **6.** Contact Representative Gary Day.
